Mornings

- School gates **open at 8.40am** and close at 8.55am.
- When children come through the gate, they go straight into school.

Lunches

- School lunches currently cost £2.20 per day (this will go up slightly in September) and can be paid for on Arbor, unless your child is eligible for free school meals.
- Children are given 3 options to choose from each day, 1 of which is always a jacket potato.
- If you would like your children to have milk during morning break time, you will need to register and pay through Cool Milk. Children eligible for FSM will need to let Mrs Coombe know if they would like their child to receive milk.
- Children don't receive a snack during morning break, however, you can send your child into school with a healthy snack to eat during this time. Please do not send any food which contains nuts.
- If there will be changes to current lunches, please let Mrs Coombe know.

What do they need?

- Book bag / rucksack

- Reading Diary (your child will be provided with a new reading diary at the start of Year 3)
- Snack
- Wellies

Your child will be given a username and password for Spelling Shed, Times Tables Rockstars and Purple Mash. These will be stuck in the front of their reading diary.
